**ARRANGEMENT
BETWEEN
THE BUREAU FOR HUMAN RESOURCE DEVELOPMENT AND ORGANIZATION
THE MINISTRY OF YOUTH AND SPORTS OF THE REPUBLIC OF INDONESIA
AND
DIVISION OF GLOBAL SPORT MANAGEMENT TALENT DEVELOPMENT
SEOUL NATIONAL UNIVERSITY
ON
ACADEMIC COOPERATION IN THE FIELD OF SPORTS**

The Ministry of Youth and Sports of the Republic of Indonesia – Bureau for Human Resource Development and Organization (hereinafter referred to as “MYS Indonesia”) and **Seoul National University - Division of Global Sport Management Talent Development** (hereinafter referred to as “SNU”), hereinafter referred to collectively as “the Parties” and individually as “the Party”,

DESIRING to strengthen the cooperation on academic field through “Dream Together Master” (hereinafter referred to as “DTM”) scholarship program.

CONSIDERING to provide the opportunity for the employees of MYS Indonesia with recognition and professional development in the field of sports.

REFERRING TO the letter from the Director of Global Sport Management Graduate Program, Seoul National University dated 8 February 2024 regarding the Cooperation Proposal for the DTM.

PURSUANT to the prevailing laws and regulations in their respective countries, have reached the following arrangement:

1. Every year, MYS Indonesia recommends 2 qualified employees of its own institution to participate in the DTM graduate program arranged by Seoul National University;
2. SNU shall provide full scholarship to the selected participants, which cover, among others:

- a. Accommodation, international round-trip airfare, tuition fees, living expenses, and other costs incurred from the DTM program during the study period in the Republic of Korea, and
 - b. Student visa and health insurance costs in the Republic of Korea.
3. The Parties shall undertake activities to promote DTM's academic programs in Indonesia.
4. The Parties shall cooperate in the recruitment process of outstanding Indonesian candidates in the field of sports, whereby:
 - a. The Parties shall advise the interested candidates to submit their applications to SNU;
 - b. MYS Indonesia shall provide a recommendation letter for qualified employees from MYS Indonesia to participate in the DTM program; and
 - c. SNU shall shortlist and/or admit the recommended candidates to enroll in the DTM program.
5. The Parties shall provide support to expand employment opportunities for alumni of DTM program in Indonesia.
6. The Parties shall ensure that participants are repatriated to Indonesia to resume work at the MYS Indonesia upon the completion of the program.
7. The Parties shall ensure that research results and collaborative agendas arising from this program shall not infringe upon the other legitimate rights of the Parties, and the Parties shall be responsible for any claims related to the copyright and validity of the use of such research and agendas in accordance with the applicable national laws in their respective countries.
8. Each Party shall ensure the security and confidentiality of documents, information, and other data obtained from or provided to the other Party during the term of this Arrangement or any other agreements entered into this Arrangement.
9. If either Party intends to disclose the confidential documents and information related to this Arrangement to any third party, the Parties shall obtain the written consent from the other Party prior to such disclosure.
10. The Parties agree that the provisions under this Arrangement shall continue to bind the Parties upon the termination of this Arrangement.
11. This Arrangement shall enter into effect on the date of its signing and shall remain in effect for a period of 5 (five) years, after which it shall be automatically extended for an additional period of the same duration.
12. Either Party may terminate this Arrangement by providing written notice of its intention to terminate this Arrangement to the other Party at least six (6) months prior to the intended date of termination.

13. The termination or expiration of this Arrangement shall not affect any ongoing program at the time of termination or expiration, unless the Parties decide otherwise.
14. Any differences arising from the interpretation or application of this Arrangement shall be settled amicably through consultations and/or negotiations between both Parties.
15. This Arrangement may be amended at any time by a mutual written consent of the Parties.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, the undersigned, have signed this Arrangement.


